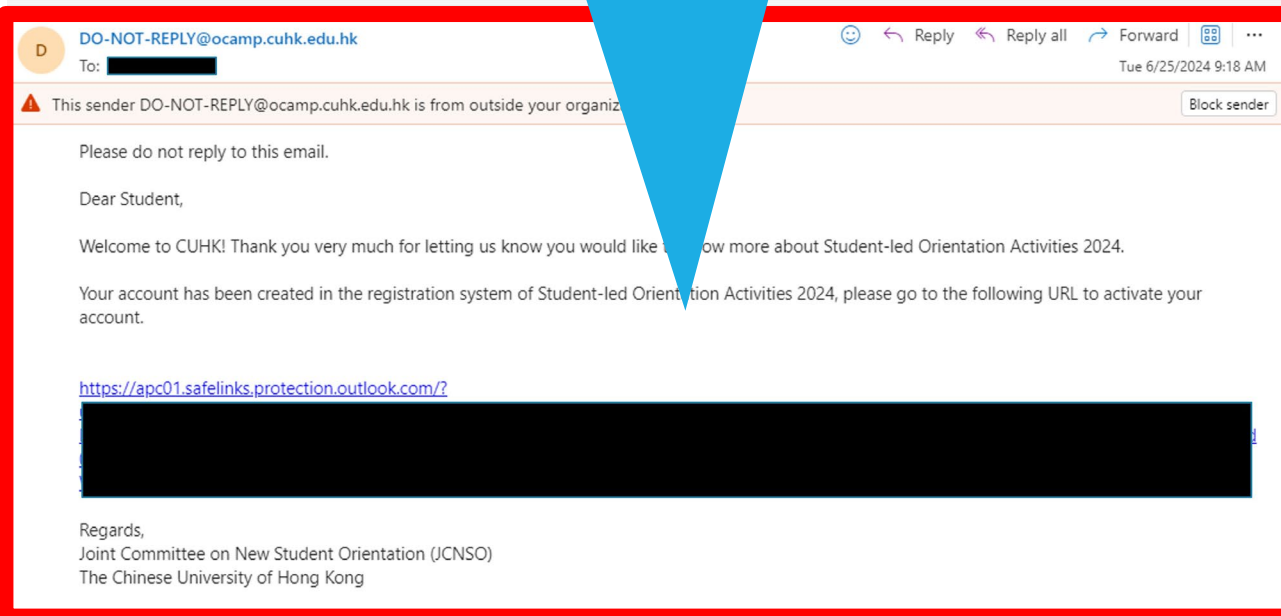

2. The official student-led orientation camps will be conducted within campus ONLY. No off-campus overnight orientation camp is allowed.

4. The orientation activities are charged. The fee covers some orientation souvenirs, such as T-shirts, bags and bottles. New students will settle the orientation fee in September via Finance Office, CUHK. For those who join charged orientation activities will receive a bill issued by the Finance Office of the University right after the new academic term starts. Please do NOT pay the organisers directly. Student organisers are not allowed to collect any fee from freshmen. For non-local students who will join the College Orientation Week, please also pay attention to point 8 as below.
5. Any withdrawal request should be raised before the orientation activities. Please contact the orientation organisers directly. You are also advised to write an email to the organisers to foster your communication with the orientation organisers. Please also confirm with them whether there is any fee. (if you join the charged online orientation.)
6. For the College Orientation Activities of Orientation Week, it is required that all participants should belong to same colleges. If you do not receive the College affiliation result by **24 August 2024 (Thursday)**, you may not be able to join the student-led College Orientation Activities.
7. For new mainland students (Gaokao – 文憑/工商), if you want to enrol Student-led Business Administration Orientation Camp / Engineering Orientation Camp / Science Orientation Camp / Social Science (Broad-based) Orientation Camps, please submit online application via <https://cloud.itsc.cuhk.edu.hk/webform/view.php?id=13667143>.
